

COMPANY POLICY

Environmental & Sustainability Policy

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1. Policy statement

Ignis Circular Ltd exists to move waste up the hierarchy — from disposal towards recycling, recovery and reuse. We operate the Canford Recycling Centre under Environment Agency Permit No. EPR/FP3393SB, and we regard full compliance with that permit as the minimum standard, not the target.

Our MBT process mechanically sorts incoming waste to recover recyclable materials, processes approximately 78% of residual waste into Refuse-Derived Fuel (RDF) for energy recovery, and biologically treats a further approximately 21% — leaving only around 1% for landfill. Sustaining and improving this approximately 99% diversion rate is our central environmental commitment.

2. Our commitments

- Apply the waste hierarchy to every tonne received: prevention, reuse, recycling, recovery and only then disposal.
- Prevent pollution of air, land and water through bunded storage, sealed drainage, dust suppression and planned preventative maintenance of all abatement plant.
- Manage odour, litter, noise and pests in line with our permit conditions and management system, responding promptly to any community concern.
- Measure and reduce the carbon intensity of our operations, including plant efficiency, haulage planning and energy use on site.
- Verify that every downstream outlet for recovered material and RDF is duly authorised, so value chains stay clean beyond our gate.
- Set objectives and targets, review them annually, and pursue continual improvement consistent with ISO 14001 principles.

3. Working with others

We share diversion and recycling data openly with customers to support their environmental reporting, work constructively with the Environment Agency and local authorities, and expect our suppliers and contractors to meet the environmental standards we set for ourselves.

4. Responsibilities

The Director holds overall accountability for environmental performance. The Operations Director ensures permit conditions, monitoring and record-keeping are met daily. All staff receive environmental awareness training and are responsible for following the procedures that protect our compliance.
